We will have limited spaces, circles will be given first come first serve.

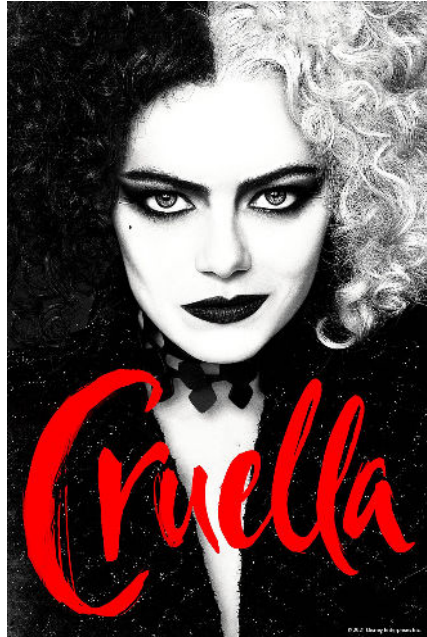

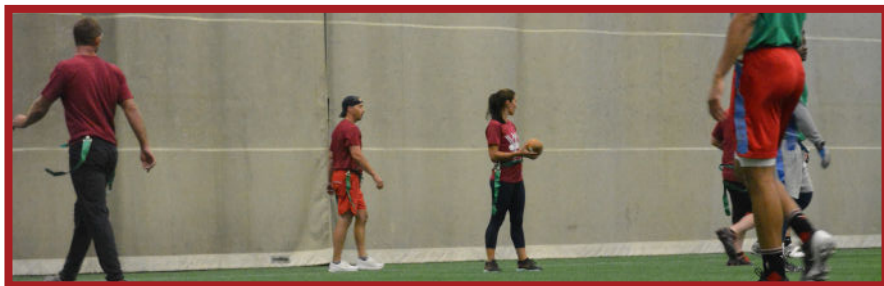
