# THE SEWER BOARD MEETING OF THE CIVIL CITY OF NEW ALBANY, INDIANA, WAS HELD IN THE THIRD FLOOR ASSEMBLY ROOM OF THE CITY-COUNTY BUILDING ON THURSDAY, APRIL 27, 2017 AT 9:15 A.M.

**PRESENT:** Ed Wilkinson, member, Nathan Grimes, member and Mayor Gahan, president.

**ALSO PRESENT:** April Dickey, Larry Summers, Rob Sartell, Linda Moeller, Mr. Gibson and Mindy Milburn

# **CALL TO ORDER:**

Mayor Gahan called the meeting to order at 9:18 a.m.

#### **PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:**

#### **APPROVAL OR CORRECTION OF THE FOLLOWING MINUTES:**

Mr. Grimes moved to approve the April 13, 2017 Regular Meeting Minutes with corrections, Mr. Wilkinson second, all voted in favor.

# **BIDS/CONTRACTS:**

# **COMMUNICATIONS - PUBLIC:**

# **COMMUNICATIONS - CITY OFFICIALS:**

Mrs. Moeller presented a packet of information from Gallagher Basset Services, Inc., who can provide them with an audit for the insurance coverage for the city. She explained that it has been many years since something like this has been done and the broker believes it would be advantageous for the city to review everything the city has in property and items such as trucks, vehicles, etc. to make sure they are insured correctly. She said that this audit will allow that to happen and renewal for this policy comes in June. She feels like they could do this correctly and expedite it so that when we do renew in June we will be looking at accurate pricing for what we own. She stated that the total cost is \$35,000.00 and that would be split between the sewer fund and redevelopment.

**Mr. Gibson** stated that Gallagher Basset Services, Inc., is the city's current insurance broker and we recently had a major inventory done of all city assets so he recommended that we take the next step which is to get those assets appraised so that we have the true, fair market value of what it would be to replace those and to ensure that we are properly covered in case anything were to happen.

Mr. Grimes asked if this was for the underground piping as well.

Mr. Gibson replied yes.

**Mr. Wilkinson** asked if they were going to give current/depreciated value or replacement value.

**Mr. Gibson** stated that he doesn't know off hand but we could probably have it done both ways if that is preferred. He then stated that we obviously need replacement value so we need our appraisal to match up with our insurance policy.

**Mr. Wilkinson** stated that if they would provide both at the same fee that would be excellent information to have.

Sewer Board April 27, 2017 **Mrs. Moeller** explained that our asset people were looking at current value because they do it by state board of accounts guidelines.

**Mr. Gibson** stated that is not what we want and that's why they think we may be a little under insured if something were to happen.

**Mr. Grimes** stated that it talks about the buildings being certificate of replacement cost, new and insurable reconstruction value so with the buildings they are giving you three different numbers.

Mr. Wilkinson moved to approve funding for half of the audit from Gallagher Bassett Services, Inc., Mr. Grimes second, all voted in favor.

#### **SEWER ADJUSTMENTS:**

**Mrs. Dickey** presented an adjustment request for William Cochran in the amount of \$1,402.48 for a leak at the main line. She explained that the water went into the yard and the leak was repaired by Stemler Plumbing. Supporting documents are attached.

Mr. Wilkinson moved to approve, Mr. Grimes second, all voted in favor.

#### **FINANCIAL REPORT:**

**Mr. Wilkinson** stated that the billing for the month was \$1,075,000.00 which is only about \$25,000.00 different from our average so it is right on budget.

# **NEW BUSINESS:**

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

#### 1. Wes Christmas re: Clark Dietz Update

**Mr. Christmas** stated that they are wrapping up the punch list items and site work on the Grant Line Lift Station. He also stated that he will be coordinating with Mr. Gibson on easement acquisition and property acquisition on the Old Vincennes Road project. He reported that they are in the process of getting the geotech work going on the storage project. He added that he did have their correspondence with the EPA and it was positive.

**Mr.** Wilkinson asked if they are accepting the proposal.

**Mr.** Christmas stated that they seemed to be willing to acknowledge that there is a way for us to work together to get us where we want to go. He also stated that they requested some additional information so he sent that over to Mr. Fifer.

**Mr. Gibson** stated that there wasn't any negativity in the conversation but it was more geared to finding a way to get what we need through the current structure because they basically don't want to reinvent the wheel. He also stated that they didn't want to set precedent by changing a few things here and there and then having to deal with other communities with similar requests so they were really focused on making us find a way to do it within the framework that we have. He said that he felt if we can show them a few things then it sounded like they were going to be accepting.

**Mr. Wilkinson** stated that what we are doing now is so different from what all of the old documents show.

Mr. Gibson said that they did acknowledge that certain things were not anticipated in the consent decree such as Georgetown and things of that nature but even though they acknowledge that they don't want to separate too much from it because they don't want to have to worry about what they will have to deal with for other communities. He also said that they did seem to indicate that if we produced enough data that they felt comfortable with in the framework that we are still in then we can probably get what we need.

Mayor Gahan stated that the board will just kind of stand by for future updates.

**Mr. Gibson** replied yes and stated that they have been extremely responsive as compared to the past so nothing is leading him to think that they are just going to leave this sit on their desk and collect dust.

**Mr. Wilkinson** asked if they have been dealing with the same people the last couple of times.

**Mr.** Christmas replied yes and stated that the attorney involved is the same one that has been there for a long time.

#### **UTILITY REPORT:**

**Mr. Sartell** presented the Wastewater Utility Monthly Report for February that included the following:

They are close to buttoning up the issues with American Beverage but unfortunately he found another client that may be discharging illicit substance in the same manhole so he sent them a questionnaire survey to fill out.

#### **Influent / Effluent Quality**

The treatment facility had excursions for effluent CBOD for the monthly average and weekly averages. This was due to a couple of industrial client's effluent being high CBOD content. The Utility is working with those industries to get them into compliance.

#### Pretreatment

There were 24 grease trap inspections of restaurants and food preparation facilities.

Product Specialties was issued a \$1,200.00 fine for permit violations.

## **Facility Operations**

64 dry tons of bio solids were removed from the WWTP.

The WWTP was at 56% of its Total Suspended Solids design limit and at 53% of its CBOD design limit.

There were 0.78 inches of rain for the month

#### **Preventative and Unscheduled Maintenance**

192 preventative work orders were completed and 18 corrective work orders were completed for the WWTP and Lift Stations

#### **Highlights**

The maintenance staff and Delta Electric replaced a bad circuit board in the VFD to the #2 pump in the #110 Raw Wastewater Pump Station.

Sewer Board April 27, 2017 The maintenance staff and Murphy Elevator made repairs to the man lift at the Robert E. Lee Lift Station

We sent the #8 Return Activated Sludge (RAS) pump out for repair and to have the impeller coated in ceramic to reduce wear.

We had the tires replaced on the 6 inch Thompson portable emergency pump.
