CALL TO ORDER:

Mr. Nash called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

- 1. Benny Carter re: Primos Delicatessen re: Permission to place food truck in front of business and in front of the city/county building**

- 2. Rob Tuma and Allyson Sears with Graceland Baptist Church re: Banner permit for Easter Explosion**

Rob Tuma requested permission to hang a banner on Charlestown Road by Purdue for a community event on Saturday March 26th and explained that the banner would come down the Monday after Easter.

Mr. Thompson explained that there was an issue in the grass plat that the city notified them about and this was their response to that. He stated that he doesn't know that they want to approve this until he and Mr. Summers have a chance to talk to them. He explained that the work is already done and he went down to the location while it was going on to try to contact them but he was unable to.

5. Derek Misch, Dan Chritiani re: Update on INAWC projects

Derek Misch stated that the project on 10th, 16th, Ashely and Redbud Drive will need another week of closing the parking on one side of the road, but IN-AWC asked that they hold off on Franklin Drive right now because of an issue with the easement. He explained that since Franklin is on hold they would like to start on Jay Street and presented a street closure for Ekin Avenue with the west bound lane of the Jay Street intersection closed and a parking restriction on the east side of the road starting March 21st

AT&T is planning to :

Cut the street in two locations on E 5th St between E Market St and E Spring St. Work is already complete. AT&T had to do an emergency dig up and repair in our conduit runs that required immediate attention. Restoration is complete. The first street cut (186' South of E Spring St) totaled 276 square feet of asphalt and the second street cut (280' South of E Spring St) totaled 24 square feet of asphalt.

This work is planned to start on or around: Completed first week of March, 2016

AT&T will be responsible for the work performed by our contractors, and all surfaces will be restored by our contractors after the work has been completed. We will also be responsible for any repairs that are relative to these cuts for at least one year after the proposed work has been completed.

Any and all expenses in relocation of said work in public right of way due to construction, or reconstruction of said road will be borne by AT&T.
