

THE SEWER BOARD MEETING OF THE CIVIL CITY OF NEW ALBANY, INDIANA, WAS HELD IN ROOM 100 AT NEW ALBANY CITY HALL ON THURSDAY, MARCH 13, 2025 AT 9:15 A.M.

CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Gahan called the meeting to order at 9:15 a.m.
