

## NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the Redevelopment Commission of the City of New Albany, Indiana until **11:30 A.M.** local time on the **23rd day of June, 2026** in Suite 212, City Hall, 142 E Main Street, New Albany, Indiana 47150, for the construction of the following project:

### **SILVER STREET PARK TURF FIELD EQUIPMENT PROCUREMENT**

This project consists of the furnishing and delivery of equipment for the Silver Street Park Turf Field. The scope of work is limited strictly to equipment supply and delivery. No construction, installation, or on-site labor is included in this procurement. The equipment is intended to support improvements to Silver Street Park's athletic facilities, enhancing recreational opportunities for the community.

At the hour of **12:00 P.M.** local time on the **23rd day of June, 2026** all bids for this construction will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Redevelopment Commission Meeting.

Bids shall be submitted as unit price and/or lump sum pricing for all equipment listed in the bid documents, including any alternates, and shall be submitted in duplicate on Indiana State Board of Accounts Form No. 96. An executed Form 96A or similar financial statement shall also be required.

Each bidder shall submit with its sealed bid a certified check or bid bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid, payable to the City of New Albany Redevelopment Commission. This security is required to ensure execution of the contract if awarded.

The Vendor to whom the contract is awarded will be required to furnish, prior to delivery, Certificates of Insurance as specified in the Contract Documents. No performance or payment bond is required for this procurement unless otherwise stated in the Contract Documents.

Bidder's attention is called to the provisions of Indiana Code 5-16-6 "Discrimination by Contractors and Subcontractors Prohibited".

Bidder's attention is called to the "Notice of Requirement for Affirmative Action to Ensure Equal Employment Opportunity (Executive Order 11246)", contained in the bid documents, which sets forth, in part, goals and timetables for the employment of women and minorities in the project area.

The City of New Albany is an Equal Opportunity Employer. Women and Minorities are strongly encouraged to submit bids. Section 3 Businesses are encouraged to submit bids. We comply with Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968 (12 U.S.C. 1701u) and implementing regulations at 24 CFR Part 75.

Bidder's attention is called to the fact that **Davis-Bacon prevailing wage requirements do NOT apply to this project**, as the scope is limited to equipment procurement with no construction, installation, or on-site labor.
